Another year has passed and we have been blessed with generous donors and dedicated volunteers. We are very grateful. All of you, in co-operation with French Town Veterinary Clinic, Help for Animals, and Riverbend Animal Clinic, made it possible to get 178 cats and 31 dogs spayed, and 137 cats and 13 dogs neutered (January through November). Since September 2010, when this spay neuter assistance program was founded, **2,648 cats and 405 dogs have been spayed or neutered!**

Let us explain what SNAP of Gallia County is all about, for those who may not know. French Town Veterinary Clinic in Gallipolis, Help for Animals in Barboursville, West Virginia, and Riverbend Animal Clinic in Gallipolis (when they participate) provide low-cost spays and neuters for qualified applicants. A share of that cost or the entire cost is paid by the applicant and SNAP pays for the remainder of the fee when necessary. Everyone pays something. Volunteers humanely trap feral or semi-feral cats and have them spayed or neutered and then return them to the people who feed them.

What we don't do is take cats or dogs from people who no longer want them. SNAP does not operate a shelter. We realize there are a lot of stray cats, but in Ohio there is no requirement for counties to accept cats at animal shelters, only dogs. There are people in the community who foster unwanted cats until they are placed for adoption at French Town Veterinary Clinic and Riverbend Animal Clinic. SNAP pays for the cats to be spayed or neutered and the \$20 adoption fee goes toward the cost of the surgery and vaccinations but in no way covers the total cost.

SNAP operates by donations and fundraisers. We do not receive any money from local, state, or federal government agencies. We do apply for grants when we can get volunteers to write them, but we don't have many volunteers, unfortunately. Our fundraisers and donors are absolutely essential to operating SNAP. Without them, we could not provide the assistance we do. That is why we are so grateful to everyone who supports us!

Our yard sale and Bingo fundraisers were very successful this year and we are extremely appreciative of the donations and volunteers and the people who support them by shopping and playing Bingo. Mark your calendars for the next yard sale, May 2-4, 1031 2<sup>nd</sup> Ave., Gallipolis. We accept **quality** items.

Many more cats and dogs could have been sterilized this year but several people who applied for low-cost vouchers did not make their copayments (as little as \$20 in many cases). In fact, **75 female cats, 41 female dogs, 60 male cats and 48 male dogs were not spayed or neutered.**

If you or someone you know needs help getting a dog or cat spayed or neutered, applications are available at French Town and Riverbend, or apply online by visiting our website.
